Bivolaru, Advised to Ask for Political Asylum in Sweden by the Priest Ulla Sandbaek, Member of the European Parliament

We have reported on the fact that Guru Bivolaru's followers from Sweden and Denmark hold a press conference in Malmo a few days ago to support their mentor. As for what has been said in the press conference in Malmo, the press release given to the Romanian media is significantly different from what the Swedish press stated.

According to an article in the well-known Swedish newspaper, “Expressen”, article signed by Ola Hanson (one of the most famous Swedish journalists, a specialist in human rights issues) it was Ulla Sandbaek – a former member of the European Parliament during two legislative sessions, between 1996 and 2004 – who suggested Gregorian Bivolaru to ask political asylum in Sweden. The former MEP admitted in front of the Swedish journalists that she had met Bivolaru in Denmark, a few weeks before he went to Sweden, and advised him to ask for political asylum in Sweden and not in Denmark. Also, Ulla Sandbaek confirmed to the Swedish journalists that she had been aware that Gregorian Bivolaru was internationally searched following a warrant issued by the Romanian authorities. Therefore, the former MEP implicitly admitted that she had broken the Danish legislation, which just like the Romanian one, punishes complicity to criminals searched on an international warrant.

The member of the European Parliament, a defender of the homosexuals

An interesting thing to know about Ulla Sandbaek is that besides being a member of the European Parliament she is a notorious activist for the defense of the sexual minorities in Denmark. Also, Ulla Sandbaek is a priest in a Christian cult in Denmark and a fervent militant for the official recognition of the homosexual marriages.

According to the “Expressen” newspaper, Ulla Sanbaek suggested to the Guru not to ask political asylum in Denmark, but in Sweden, because the political regime in Copenhagen is now one of the most restrictive in Europe as concerns emigration and the sexual deviations.

Sandbaek, who is still directly acting in a political movement in her country, Denmark, defended Grieg in the press conference as well as she could, stressing the various “persecutions” that Bivolaru and his followers are suffering in Romania.

One of the leaders of the M.I.S.A. branch in Denmark, Mikael Eriksson made some arousing statements during the same press conference.
